PRACTICUM OPTIONS

As a full time direct practice student, you have 2 practicum options.

Option 1: Plan a practicum for the spring semester. This placement is 16 weeks long and approximately 40 hours/week.

Option 2: Plan a practicum that will begin in the spring and extend into the summer making it more “part-time.” This placement is 16 weeks in the spring and 12 in the summer and approximately 18 hours/week.

ELECTIVE INFORMATION: Students are required to take 6 hours of electives. If not completed by the beginning of the concentration curriculum, please meet with an advisor about when to complete them.
